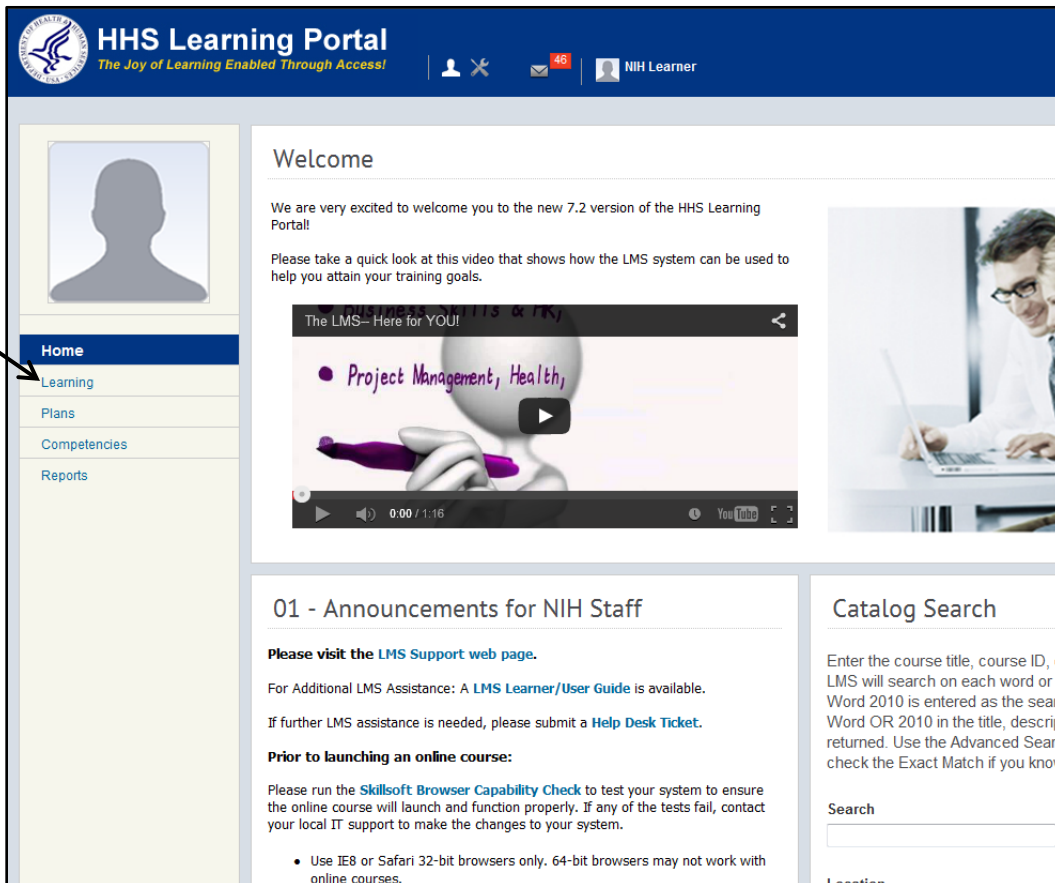


Figure 1 – Learning link on LMS Home Page
